DOE/FECM ORDER NO. 4820

On May 9, 2022, the Office of Fossil Energy and Carbon Management (FECM) of the Department of Energy (DOE) issued DOE/FECM Order No. 4820 to Energy Source Natural Gas Inc. (Energy Source Natural Gas) under section 3(c) of the Natural Gas Act, 15 U.S.C. § 717b(c). Ordering Paragraph A, at page 3 of the above-referenced Order, is hereby corrected to read as follows:

- A. Energy Source Natural Gas is authorized for the activity described in the list below. This authorization shall be effective for a two-year term beginning on July 1, 2022, and extending through June 30, 2024.
 - 1. Import natural gas from Canada by pipeline at any point on the border between the United States and Canada
 - 2. Export natural gas to Canada by pipeline at any point on the border between the United States and Canada

The applicant is authorized to import and export up to a combined total volume equivalent to 1 Bcf of natural gas.

Additionally, Ordering Paragraph C, at page 4 of the above-referenced Order, is hereby corrected to read as follows:

C. The first monthly report required by this Order is due not later than August 30, 2022, and should cover the reporting period from July 1, 2022 through July 31, 2022.

All other Findings and Ordering Paragraphs in DOE/FECM Order No. 4820 remain in full force and effect.
