The Corps prefers to be notified early, preferably before a notice of intent is issued, especially if it is a potential cooperating agency. Initial contact should be addressed to the local Corps district office, listed at [usace.army.mil/Locations](http://usace.army.mil/Locations).

DOI requests that a review request for a draft or final EIS be sent to the Headquarters Office of Environmental Policy and Compliance, which will provide it to DOI bureaus and regional offices.
