The parties discussed the development of the new consensus standard test procedure for televisions, ANSI/CTA-2037-C, and related stakeholder participation. The parties also discussed expected near-term changes to the test procedure standard, which is expected to result in a "version D." The parties then discussed International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC) activity regarding the revision of the existing IEC test method for TVs, and how the IEC activity relates to the CTA standards activity. The parties provided a status update on the development of an energy efficiency voluntary agreement for TVs. Lastly, the parties discussed current thinking and potential approaches to revising the current federal test method for TVs.
