Re: Order Condition O – Semi-Annual Report

DOE/FE Order No. 3331-A, under FE Docket No. 11-128-LNG

By Order No. 3331-A (Order) dated May 7, 2015, the U.S. Department of Energy, Office of Fossil Energy (DOE/FE) authorized Cove Point LNG, LP¹ (Cove Point) to export liquefied natural gas (LNG) in a volume equivalent to 0.77 billion cubic feet of natural gas per day (Bcf/d) (281 Bcf per year (Bcf/yr)) through December 31, 2050.²

As required under Ordering Paragraph O, Cove Point hereby submits a semi-annual report regarding the progress of its Cove Point Liquefaction Project. Construction of the facility is complete, and Cove Point is currently producing LNG. Cove Point continues to export LNG and reports those exports to the DOE in its monthly reports.
