Dear Ms. Wood:

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph O of DOE/FE Order No. 4078,¹ Eagle LNG Partners Jacksonville II LLC (“Eagle Maxville”) submits its semi-annual report providing an update in respect of the development status of and export-related activities associated with the Eagle Maxville liquefaction facility.

The Eagle Maxville liquefaction facility is currently operational and commenced first exports of LNG via ISO container in August 2021. Eagle Maxville has executed one export contract since its prior semi-annual report, in the form of an amended agreement with an off-taker in a non-FTA country, dated July 1, 2022, which is in the process of being filed with the DOE.

Eagle Maxville has previously submitted all of its executed long-term LNG export agreements to the DOE, and will continue to submit monthly reports to the DOE summarizing monthly exports. Eagle Maxville will continue to update the DOE as other export agreements progress and as additional LNG volumes are exported.
