TO MEMBERS OF COMMITTEE ON MILITARY AND GOVERNMENT PETROLEUM REQUIREMENTS

The November 3, 1947 statement of Military Requirements and Offers (data as of October 31, 1947) failed to include, an offer of 405,000 barrels of motor gasoline by an individual company for lifting from the U.S. Gulf Coast during the July-December, 1947 period.

The amount of motor gasoline still uncovered in the Gulf/E.Coast/Caribbean area as of October 31, 1947 was, therefore, 354,000 barrels instead of 759,000 barrels shown in the November 3rd statement. The worldwide coverage was, accordingly, 98.2% instead of 92.5% shown in the statement.

This information was obtained from the A.N.P.B. statement "Tentative Offers Received - Not Confirmed as of 31 October, 1947". The item was overlooked in the information obtained by telephone on November 3rd for preparation of the statement of that date.
