TO MEMBERS OF THE MILITARY AND GOVERNMENT PETROLEUM REQUIREMENTS COMMITTEE:

Gentlemen:

Attached is a summary of the Military petroleum requirements situation as of March 31, 1948. Since the last report, requirement estimates for the January-June 1948 period have been revised downward by 2,740,000 barrels. The downward revisions were in Navy Special and Other Residual Fuel Oils and a slight change in Aviation Gasoline. Estimated requirements for Motor Gasoline were increased by 500,000 barrels.

Industry offers have increased since the last report so that the coverage against presently estimated requirements for the January-June period was 95.4% as of March 31st. The Procurement Branch of the Armed Services advise that with the offers shown in this report and pending negotiations they expect to fully cover the actual military requirements over the remainder of the fiscal year. Therefore, they do not expect to request additional offers for this period.

Requirement figures shown for the fiscal year 1948 are a combination of the actual liftings during the July to December 1947 period and the estimated requirements for the January-June 1948 period. On this basis the present coverage for the full fiscal year is 97.8%.

Offers of Aviation Gasoline, Other Diesel and Burner Oils, and Navy Special Fuel Oil are in excess of the estimated requirements.

No further report will be made regarding the fiscal year 1948 until July 1948 unless there is an unusual and important change in the situation.
