ORDER VACATING AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS FROM CANADA BY TRUCK

DOE/FECM ORDER NO. 4709-A

NOVEMBER 21, 2022

On May 27, 2021, in DOE/FE Order No. 4709, the Office of Fossil Energy and Carbon Management (FECM)¹ of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Potelco, Inc. (Potelco) to import liquefied natural gas (LNG) from Canada by truck, in a total volume equivalent to 149.99 billion cubic feet (Bcf) of natural gas. This blanket authorization extends for a two-year term beginning on July 31, 2021, and extending through July 30, 2023.

On October 19, 2022, Potelco notified DOE that this authorization is no longer needed.² Potelco therefore, requests that DOE vacate Order No. 4709, effective October 19, 2022. DOE finds good cause to do so.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, Potelco's blanket authorization to import LNG from Canada by truck, in a total volume equivalent to 149.99 Bcf of natural gas, granted in DOE/FE Order No. 4709 on May 27, 2021, is hereby vacated, effective October 19, 2022.
