**Confirmation of Termination of LNG Sales and Purchase Agreement (LNG SPA)**

Dear Ms. Sweeney:

On November 21, 2012, the Department of Energy Office of Fossil Energy (DOE/FE) issued an order granting CE FLNG long-term multi-contract authorization to export up to 8 million metric tons per year (mtpa) of liquefied natural gas (LNG) from its proposed LNG Terminal in Plaquemines Parish, Louisiana to Free Trade Agreement countries for a 30-year term, which included the LNG Sale and Purchase Agreement (“SPA”) between CE FLNG LLC (“CE FLNG”) and CEGE (“CEGL”) that CE FLNG and CEGE entered into on May 10, 2013. By this letter, CE FLNG LLC notifies DOE that the SPA between CE FLNG and CEGE is no longer in effect as of December 31, 2020. The LNG SPA was entered into during the earliest stage of the project and through CE FLNG’s semi annual filings the company indicated that it was reviewing modifications and extensions. Thus, in order to maintain an accurate administrative record, the LNG SPA may be removed from the DOE website as CE FLNG continues to actively engage with third parties regarding the global energy situation, including meeting clean energy ESG requirements for Investors and offtake agreements. CE FLNG will file a copy of any long-term contracts, including long-term supply contracts, within 30 days of execution in accordance with DOE/FE Orders 3193
