Needs/Challenges:

The average age of MPS buildings is 75.4 years.

The number of facilities and size of the facilities is greater than the funds available for allocation to make adequate replacements on time.



Difficult decisions must be made regarding the total number, placement, and usage of district facilities; after those decisions are made, large capital investments, including deferred maintenance, can be prioritized toward the buildings most in need and those planned to be used moving forward.
