

# Greenup County School District (Greenup, KY)

The Greenup County School District (GCHS) in northeast Kentucky will undergo energy improvements in three schools. GCHS will replace the roof, install solar electric panels, install solar thermal water heating technology, replace lighting, and replace 18 single pane windows. The proposed project, supported by an energy savings performance contract (ESPC), will enable the implementation of a wide range of energy conservation technologies. In addition, the district is starting a Green Energy Pathway for high school students to learn more about the green energy industry, leading them to prepare for future jobs or business adventures to come to the area. Two middle schools will upgrade to geothermal heating/cooling technology. In addition, GCHS will explore alternative fueled vehicles as an innovation around energy efficiency in communities by purchasing four alternative fueled buses and building charging infrastructure in their community.
