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What is ICPT?

- Established in 1997; collaboration among DOE sites to pursue strategic sourcing opportunities
- Standardized price lists for common commodities
- Competitively awarded or sole source
- 64% of Agreements with small businesses or small resellers
- Most deeply discounted
- Ability to be used by any DOE sites
- Managed by a volunteer Steering Committee
- Agreements awarded and administered by individual M&O sites



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Benefits of ICPT

- The primary benefit = time savings!
- Ease of use, efficiency in contract award process "Golden Ticket" for competition and price reasonableness
- Competitive pricing with pre-negotiated discounts no need to negotiate further!
- Terms and Conditions already negotiated/accepted
- Bringing more efficiency and cost savings to DOE achieving their vision to:

"create a comprehensive DOE (Federal and Contractor) approach that truly is enterprise wide and strategically driven to ensure maximum value for every acquisition dollar spent."

Average annual savings of >\$300M!



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Benefits of ICPT

- Small business partnerships over half of ICPT Agreements are with small businesses or large business resellers
- Broader, easier supplier access to DOE M&O contractors to increase volume
- Ability for suppliers to gain DOE/government contracting experience



What is the SCMC?

- Strategic supply chain management program founded in 2006, serving mainly NNSA and DOE EM sites
- A focused, funded approach to facilitate strategic sourcing to leverage a projected \$6.8B (FY2023) in spending across the enterprise
- Enables cost savings and/or cost avoidance
- Simplifies the buying process
- Improves operational efficiency




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25 DOE Sites Nationwide

Following April 4, 2022, SAM gov has transitioned to a Unique Entity Identifier (UEI) in place of using a Dun & Bradstreet (DUNS) number. You must register directly with SAM.cov for your UEL You are no longer required obtain a DUNS number. This transition allows the government to streamline the entity identification process, making it easier and less burdensome for entities to do business with the federal government

The SCMC is using the 2022 NAICS Codes and size standards that have been approved by the Small Business Administration (SBA) as of December for inflation. A list of the size standards can be found on the SBA website. A size standard, which is usually state in number of employees or average annual receipts, re the largest size that a business (including its subsidiaries and affiliates) may be to remain classified as a small business for SBA and federal contracting of "small" varies by industry
