RE: Statement of supplemental information regarding exporting Renewable Natural Gas by Pipeline.

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Irving Oil Terminals Inc is looking to start purchasing Renewable Natural Gas solutions in the US with the possibility of selling some of that volume into Canada. This RNG will be comingled in the pipe with regular natural gas.

In our first option we will purchase from a supplier in Johnston, Rhode Island. This RNG is derived from Food Waste and will be in the range of 800 MMBtu/day. We are looking to potentially start this in September. The plan will be to sell this into Canada with the option of selling some into the US as well.

In our second option we are looking to purchase from a supplier in Lethbridge, Alberta. This will be derived from Dairy Manure and Food Waste. This volume will only be transiting through the US as it will go back into Canada. This will be recorded as an in-transit movement, and we are looking to start this in September as well.

As suggested, we will include the RNG volume in the "Notes" section when reporting our monthly reports for natural gas through the DOE Portal.
