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Details

I (b) (6) while working the Site 300 Main Gate, was informed by Site 300 Employee (b) (6) that he saw a drone hovering above the Site 300 Fire Department. (b) (6) reported this information to me through a casual conversation about the fire at approx. 1530 hours. The Alameda County Fire Dept. (ACFD) had responded to a fire at Carnegie Motorcycle Park approx. 45 min. to 1 hour earlier. At the time of (b) (6) (b) (6) initial conversation with me, I didn't see any sign of a drone. I stated to (b) (6) (b) (6) that I did see numerous aircraft in the air (helicopters, spotter planes and air tankers). I feel it was possible that some of the aircraft in the air at the time could have been mistaken for a drone.

(b) (6) advised all Site 300 patrols to be on the look out for possible drone activity at Site 300. Therefore there was no need for me to inform the Central Alarm Station (CAS) or (b) (6) (b) (6) about the conversation with (b) (6) concerning a possible drone sighting.
