Re: Request for Amendment – LNG Export Authorization (Order No. 4772, Docket No. 21-99-LNG)

Ms. Sweeney:

On behalf of Carib Energy (USA), LLC (“Carib Energy”), and as directed by the Department of Energy’s (DOE) Office of Fossil Energy and Carbon Management (FECM), I hereby request an amendment to the level of LNG volumes previously authorized for re-export by Order No. 4772 (Docket No. 21-99-LNG).


On December 20, 2021, FECM issued Order No. 4772, which authorized Carib Energy to export previously imported LNG in ISO containers by vessel to Free Trade Agreement (FTA) and non-FTA nations. The Order further authorized Carib Energy to export 0.48 billion cubic feet (Bcf) of natural gas on a cumulative basis for a two-year period beginning on the earlier of the date of first export or five years from the date the Order was issued. Carib Energy subsequently began exporting previously imported LNG under the terms of this authorization on April 6, 2022.

On August 28, 2023 we received a communication from FECM notifying us that, as of the July/August, 2023 period, Carib Energy had exceeded the cumulative 0.48 Bcf of LNG authorized for export under Order No. 4772. FECM further instructed that, were Carib Energy to continue exporting LNG under the terms of its DOE authorization, it must request an amendment to Order No. 4772 authorizing an increased cumulative volume to cover both the excess volumes to date and any further volumes Carib Energy estimated would be needed for the remaining term of its current authorization.

Accordingly, please consider this letter Carib Energy’s request for an amendment to the LNG export authorization previously approved by Order No. 4772. Specifically, Carib Energy requests an increase in the cumulative export volume afforded Carib Energy under this authorization from .048 Bcf to 1.4 Bcf, effective July 1, 2023. Carib Energy requests no other changes or amendments to its authorization under Order No. 4772.
