





#### Q: When will the voucher application be available?

A: November 2023! Look for an email with more details once the application portal is live

#### Q: What do we need to include in our voucher application?

A: The full voucher application will become available once the application portal is live. For now, check out the Voucher Handbook and Voucher Application templates for a preview of the information you may need in your voucher application.

## Ask the Expert: Voucher Program with Allison Robinson



**Q: What are the limitations of choosing the voucher option?** A: There are a few limitations to consider:

Technical Assistance Voucher	Equipment Rebate Voucher
Vouchers may not be sub-granted TA Voucher recipients may not select their own TA provider – the provider will be DOE's TA administrator TA vouchers cannot cover staff time Activities must fall within the NEPA Determination of allowable activities	<ul> <li>Vouchers may not be sub- granted</li> <li>Vouchers cannot be used to cover administrative staff time however; it can be used to cover in-house installation costs.</li> </ul>

#### Q: How do vouchers work with the blueprints?

A: You can choose to utilize a blueprint whether you're choosing the grant option or voucher option! Remember, you don't have to follow all the key activities in a blueprint.

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## **Energy Efficiency Conservation Strategy (EECS)**

#### **Requirements for Local Gov's & Tribes:**

- ✓ A description of the goals for increased energy efficiency and conservation in your jurisdiction
- ✓ A plan for the use of the grant to assist you in achieving those goals

#### AND, for local gov's only:

- ✓ Take into account any plans for the use of funds by adjacent eligible units of local governments that receive grants under the EECBG Program;
- Coordinate and share information with the State to maximize benefits

*How to Submit Your EECS if You're a Local Gov. or Tribe:* 

For the grant option, you must submit your EECS through one of two methods:

- 1) With your application through the PAGE system when you apply, or
- 2) Not later than 1 Year after the effective date of the award

For the voucher option, you must submit your EECS with your application.

What are your government's existing energy efficiency goals?

Will you follow a blueprint? How will this blueprint help you meet your goals?



Provide a description of your project & the category of eligible work it falls under.



How will you coordinate, partner, and engage with key stakeholders: other governments, utilities, community groups, labor unions?



How will you finance your project over time and/or leverage additional funds?



Are you incorporating J40 principles into your project? How does your project serve DACs?

## Ask the Expert: EECS & NREL Support with Nathan Wiltse



#### Q: Do all the questions in the template need to be answered?

A: If you are planning on submitting your EECS with your EECBG application, only Part A is required, and Part B is optional. If you intend to submit your EECS within 1 year of submitting your EECBG application (grants only), then Part A and B are both required.

# Q: Does a Climate Action Plan (CAP) meet the requirements of the EECS on its own?

A: No! The CAP could inform the EECS, but the EECS includes information more specific to your EECBG project and grant implementation

## Q: I don't see the EECS section in the EECBG Application in PAGE. Where can we find it?

A: The EECS is also known as the "Strategy File" in PAGE.

## Q: We're interested in receiving EECS support from NREL, what does this entail?

A: NREL EECS TA can assist with a wide range of activities; help you craft language, perform analyses, provide templates, review your EECS, & more! E.g.:

- Thinking of municipal retrofits? We can help you identify which buildings to focus on
- Looking to finance with a revolving loan fund? We can match you with an expert to work through fund structures and interactions with tax credits and other incentives
- Don't have an existing climate or energy plan? We can help you identify key goals

#### Determine if your project is compliant with federal regulations

outlined in the <u>ALRD</u> (Grant & Voucher):

- 1. Davis-Bacon
- 2. National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA
- 3. Build America Buy America (BABA)

- **X** No! Construction, alteration, and/or repair of public buildings or works
- <u>DBA assurance letter template</u>

Yes! Falls within a blueprint

 ✓ Yes!< \$250,000 = exempt from BABA requirements

## **Townsville Maximizes Their Impact Beyond the Grant Period**





 ✓ Build the foundation for municipal retrofits through data collection and benchmarking
