Description:

B5.16 Solar photovoltaic systems

The installation, modification, operation, and removal of commercially available solar photovoltaic systems located on a building or other structure (such as rooftop, parking lot or facility, and mounted to signage, lighting, gates, or fences), or if located on land, generally comprising less than 10 acres within a previously disturbed or developed area. Covered actions would be in accordance with applicable requirements (such as local land use and zoning requirements) in the proposed project area and would incorporate appropriate control technologies and best management practices.

Rationale for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is proposing to provide funding to Red Cloud Renewable (RCR) to customize and implement a solar photovoltaic (PV) system installation training program and supportive services for female Native Americans. Award activities would include outreach activities at Tribal gatherings and events (e.g., pow-wows). Women from federally recognized Tribes would be recruited and receive training at RCR facilities in the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation (PRIR) of South Dakota. Training courses would include working with relevant tools and equipment, practicing PV system installation in a laboratory setting, obtaining relevant safety and health certificates, acquiring skills and knowledge for obtaining a job in the industry, and participating in the design, pricing, and installation of PV systems (roof- and ground-mounted) at residential sites in PRIR. The total area which would be occupied by all PV systems to be installed would not exceed ten acres. Prior to PV installation activities at each residential site, the responsible Tribal Historic Preservation Office (THPO) would be contacted to analyze residential sites.

RCR facilities are preexisting purpose-built facilities for the type of work to be conducted for this award. Facility modifications would not be required. Award activities would involve typical hazards associated with PV system installations, including handling and use of hazardous materials, operation of potentially hazardous equipment, and site-specific environmental hazards. Existing health, safety, and environmental policies and procedures would be followed to mitigate hazards to acceptable levels. Mitigated hazards would pose negligible risks to the public and environment. All activities would comply with existing applicable laws and regulations.

DOE has considered the scale, duration, and nature of proposed activities to determine potential impacts on resources, including those of an ecological, historical, cultural, and socioeconomic nature. DOE does not anticipate impacts on these resources which would be considered significant or require DOE to consult with other agencies or stakeholders. All necessary permissions from communities and their respective authorities would be obtained prior to any personnel traveling to communities and performing on-site activities.

DOE has made a final NEPA determination.

Include the following condition in the financial assistance agreement:

Prior to initiating any installation activities for a photovoltaic (PV) system at any residential site at the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation (PRIR), Red Cloud Renewable (RCR) will contact the Oglala Sioux Tribe Tribal Historic Preservation Officer (THPO) to request an analysis of the site. RCR will forward the THPO's findings to DOE (gonepa@ee.doe.gov). DOE will review the THPO's findings and determine if the ND (GFO-0010822-001) would still be applicable for the site or if additional review would be required.

Prior to initiating any installation activities for a ground-mounted PV system at any residential site at PRIR, RCR will send the proposed installation location and potential area of effect to DOE (gonepa@ee.doe.gov). DOE will review the area details and determine if the ND (GFO-0010822-001) would still be applicable for the site or if additional review would be required. This condition does not apply to roof-mounted PV systems or if the proposed installation site is regularly maintained (e.g., landscaped or mowed) and was regularly maintained before the site was considered for this award.

There are no extraordinary circumstances related to the proposed action that may affect the significance of the environmental effects of the proposal.

The proposed action has not been segmented to meet the definition of a categorical exclusion. This proposal is not connected to other actions with potentially significant impacts (40 CFR 1508.25(a)(1)), is not related to other actions with individually insignificant but cumulatively significant impacts (40 CFR 1508.27(b)(7)), and is not precluded by 40 CFR 1506.1 or 10 CFR 1021.211 concerning limitations on actions during preparation of an environmental impact statement.

The proposed action is categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
