On behalf of the Calcasieu Parish Police Jury, I respectfully urge the Department of Energy's Office of Fossil Energy and Carbon Management (DOE FECM) to promptly review and approve Magnolia LNG, LLC's (Magnolia LNG) new application to export liquefied natural gas (LNG) to nations with which the United States does not have a free trade agreement.


Magnolia LNG will generate local jobs, regional economic development, and global energy security, while using innovative, proprietary liquefaction technology that significantly lowers greenhouse gas emissions when compared to conventional LNG processes. This technology is central to the role the project's owner, Glenfarne Energy Transition (Glenfarne), is building as a leader in the global energy transition, with a platform that includes solar, hydro, wind, grid stability, and low-emissions LNG.
