

Proposed Action Title: Post 2028 Parker-Davis Project Marketing Initiative

Program or Field Office: Western Area Power Administration - Desert Southwest Region

Location(s) (City/County/State): Arizona, California, Nevada

Proposed Action Description:

The Desert Southwest Region (DSW) of the Western Area Power Administration (WAPA) is proposing to extend its power resource commitments, create a resource pool, and add criteria to or amend certain criteria of the existing Parker-Davis Project Marketing Plan. The existing Parker-Davis Project Marketing Plan will expire on September 30, 2028, and a new plan is expected to be effective October 1, 2028. To accomplish this, WAPA plans to meet with customers and interested parties, work to develop a proposed marketing plan, and have several public meetings in accordance with applicable regulations prior to the new marketing initiative taking effect.

There are no extraordinary circumstances related to the proposal that may affect the significance of the environmental effects of the proposal.

The proposal has not been segmented to meet the definition of a categorical exclusion. This proposal is not connected to other actions with potentially significant impacts (40 CFR 1508.25(a)(1)), is not related to other actions with individually insignificant but cumulatively significant impacts (40 CFR 1508.27(b)(7)), and is not precluded by 40 CFR 1506.1 or 10 CFR 1021.211 concerning limitations on actions during preparation of an environmental impact statement.

Based on my review of the proposed action, as NEPA Compliance Officer (as authorized under DOE Order 451.1B), I have determined that the proposed action fits within the specified class(es) of action, the other regulatory requirements set forth above are met, and the proposed action is hereby categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
