On August 31, 2022, in DOE/FECM Order No. 4869, the Office of Fossil Energy and

Carbon Management (FECM) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization

to Atlantic Power Energy Services (US) LLC (Atlantic Power Energy Services (US)) to import

and export a combined total of 132 billion cubic feet (Bcf) of natural gas from and to Canada by

pipeline. This blanket authorization is effective for a two-year term beginning on September 18,

2022, and extending through September 17, 2024.

On March 1, 2024, Atlantic Power Energy Services (US) notified DOE that this

authorization is no longer needed. Atlantic Power Energy Services (US) therefore requests that

DOE vacate Order No. 4869, effective March 2, 2024. DOE finds good cause to do so.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, Atlantic Power Energy

Services (US)' blanket authorization to import and export a combined total of 132 Bcf of natural

gas from and to Canada, granted in DOE/FECM Order No. 4869 on August 31, 2022, is hereby

vacated, effective March 2, 2024.
