Good morning,

On March 10, 2023, your client, GULFSTREAM LNG DEVELOPMENT, LLC (Gulfstream LNG), submitted an application requesting authority to export LNG to both FTA and non-FTA countries. On June 26, 2023, in DOE/FECM [Order No. 5014](#), DOE granted the FTA portion of that application. The non-FTA portion of the application remains pending.

On March 22, 2024, Gulfstream LNG submitted [an amendment](#) to the application (as corrected on April 4, 2024) to “substitute a new site on which the Project will be constructed,” pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 590.204(a). As you know, DOE is currently processing the requested amendment to the non-FTA portion of the application, [89 Fed. Reg. 38,114](#) (May 7, 2024). We note, however, that the amendment is focused on the non-FTA application and does not appear to provide notice of an amendment to Order No. 5014, as required by [10 C.F.R. § 590.407](#) (“Reports of changes”).

As a courtesy, Gulfstream LNG may respond to this email if preferable, asking that DOE construe the amendment application as a notice of a change to Order No. 5014, pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 590.407. DOE will then process the amendment to Order No. 5014.
