ORDER VACATING AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS FROM CANADA BY TRUCK, AND
TO EXPORT LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS TO CANADA BY TRUCK

DOE/FECM ORDER NO. 4977-A

On March 12, 2023, in DOE/FECM Order No. 4977, the Office of Fossil Energy and Carbon Management (FECM) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Ferus Natural Gas Fuels Inc. (Ferus Natural Gas Fuels) to import liquefied natural gas (LNG) from Canada by truck, in a total volume equivalent to 5 billion cubic feet (Bcf) of natural gas, and to export LNG to Canada by truck, in a total volume equivalent to 5 Bcf of natural gas. This blanket authorization extends for a two-year term that began on April 30, 2023, and extending through April 29, 2025.

On February 27, 2024, Cryopeak Energy Solutions Corporation, the successor entity to Ferus Natural Gas Fuels, notified DOE that the authorization granted in Order No. 4977 is no longer needed.¹ Ferus Natural Gas Fuels therefore requests that DOE vacate Order No. 4977, effective February 1, 2024.² DOE finds good cause to do so.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, Ferus Natural Gas Fuels' blanket authorization to import LNG from Canada by truck, in a total volume equivalent to 5 Bcf of natural gas, and to export LNG to Canada by truck, in a total volume equivalent to 5 Bcf of natural gas, granted in DOE/FECM Order No. 4977 on March 12, 2023, is hereby vacated, effective February 1, 2024.
