Additionally, the Application should specify that the authorization requested would be: "effective on the date of first exportation under this authorization, and terminate on December 31, 2050." Any indication of effective or termination dates or another duration, in the Application aside from that stated in the immediately preceding sentence should be disregarded and is incorrect.
