









\$25 Million Available For Tribal Clean Energy Planning and Development

A quick guide about the latest funding opportunity from the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Office of Indian Energy.

DOE is soliciting applications for \$25 million in new funding to support the planning, assessment, and development of clean energy projects on Tribal buildings or Tribal lands. The awards issued under this funding opportunity announcement (FOA) build on the Office of Indian Energy's past investments and sustained efforts to maximize the development and deployment of energy solutions for the benefit of American Indians and Alaska Natives.

Deadline to Apply: January 23, 2025, at 5 p.m. ET

Eligible Applicants: Indian Tribes, which include Alaska Native Regional Corporations and Village Corporations, Intertribal Organizations, and Tribal Energy Development Organizations

DOE anticipates making approximately 20 to 40 awards that range from \$100,000 to \$2,500,000.

Total of \$25 million available for:

- Tribal clean energy planning
- Comprehensive clean energy feasibility and viability assessments
- Design and development of clean energy projects.

Are you eligible?

Are you an Indian Tribe, which includes Alaska Native Regional Corporations or Village Corporations, an
Intertribal Organization, or a Tribal Energy Development Organization (see Section III.A.)?
Does your project fit into one of the Topic Areas described in the FOA (see Section I.B)?
Can you commit to a 10% cost share of the total allowable costs of the project or qualify for a reduced cost
