

# How to Get a Home Electrification and Appliance Rebate



Home Electrification and Appliance Rebates provide instant discounts on household purchases that can lower monthly utility bills while improving the comfort and safety of your home.

Depending on the eligible products in your state, you can save up to **\$14,000** on upgrades, including up to:

**\$8,000** for a heat pump for space heating/cooling\*

**\$4,000** for an electrical panel

**\$2,500** for electrical wiring

**\$1,750** for a heat pump water heater\*

**\$1,600** for insulation, air sealing, and mechanical ventilation

**\$840** for a heat pump clothes dryer\*

**\$840** for an electric stove, cooktop, range, or oven\*

Sarah uses a **retailer** to purchase a new stove.



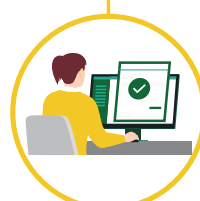
### Begin Shopping

Sarah shops online for a new stove.



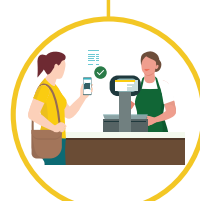
### Verify Eligibility

Sarah learns about the rebates, visits her [state's website](#), and enters her household and project details. (Renters must also include owner's approval.)



### Receive Approval

Sarah receives approval and a rebate reservation code from her state's program.



### Complete Purchase

She provides the rebate reservation code to the retailer, who subtracts the rebate amount from the purchase price.



### Install Upgrades

The retailer may recommend an installer, or if needed, Sarah will find a qualified contractor.



### Enjoy Cost Savings

Sarah enjoys the cost savings that her new high-efficiency electric appliance provides.



Shaun uses a **contractor** to install a new heating and cooling system.



### Explore Options

While researching options for home heating and cooling, Shaun learns about the rebates.



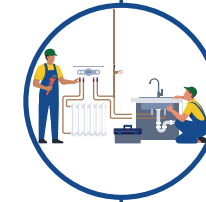
### Verify Eligibility

He visits his [state's website](#) and enters his household details. (Renters must also include owner's approval.)



### Find a Qualified Contractor

Shaun visits his [state's website](#) to find a contractor to provide a proposal. The contractor completes a home assessment and provides a quote for a heat pump.



### Install Upgrades

After the state approves Shaun's rebate, the contractor completes the installation and subtracts the rebate amount from Shaun's invoice.
