Issues Presented:

Korean representatives raised a number of concerns related to DOE's proposed Foreign Entity of Concern Interpretive Guidance.

First, they noted that they are generally concerned with wanting to ensure that Korean companies are able to maximize their ability to comply with the rules, with the impact of the rules on the cost of batteries, and with price competitiveness in the US market.

Second, they raised concerns related to graphite. Specially, they discussed the current sources of graphite used by the industry, and their belief that the rule should contain an exemption or transition period.

Third, they raised concerns related to the guidance's interpretation of "effective control." They requested clarification on what qualifies as "other contractual instruments" that can lead to effective control.

Finally, ROK representatives noted they would be submitting written comments for the record.
