Pursuant to Condition J of DOE/FE Order No. 3968 (as amended by DOE/FE Order No. 3968-A),<sup>1</sup> and Condition M of DOE/FE Order No. 4373 (as amended by DOE/FE Order No. 4373-A),<sup>2</sup> Driftwood LNG LLC ("DWLNG") is providing herein the semiannual status report for the Driftwood LNG Facility (the "Project") for the period April 1, 2024 through September 30, 2024.

DWLNG has obtained all applicable federal and state permits required for the Project at this time.

During this reporting period, construction continued for the Project. Construction activities included site preparation, excavation and backfill, storm water management, pile driving, and maintenance of site roads and drainage efforts. Non-jurisdictional construction activities, including the construction of water wells, also continued during the reporting period.

First exports of LNG from the Project are currently anticipated to commence shortly after construction of LNG Plant 1.

Plans continue to develop and negotiate terms for long-term LNG export contracts and long-term supply contracts for the Project. In accordance with Conditions D(1) and D(2) of DOE/FE Order No. 3968, and Conditions I(i) and I(ii) of DOE/FE Order No. 4373, DWLNG will file copies of long-term contracts following execution.

On August 16, 2024, DWLNG submitted a Statement of Change in Control to DOE's Office of Fossil Energy and Carbon Management ("FECM") providing notice of an anticipated change in DWLNG's upstream ownership. On September 26, 2024, DOE/FECM issued DOE/FECM Order No. 5173 granting the change in control effective upon close of the proposed transaction.
