

## **Install Smoke Alarms**


Aligns With Standard Work Specification 2.0101.2




Select battery-operated smoke alarms that are listed and labeled in accordance with UL 217 and have sealed, non-replaceable, 10-year batteries. 2.0101.2a.



Install smoke alarms in locations required by the Authority Having Jurisdiction (AHJ) (i.e. bedroom, hallway, living room, kitchen). 2.0101.2b.



Avoid installing in locations with dead air space, or locations with excessive fresh air inlet (i.e., frequently used doors and windows).



Install the smoke alarm in accordance with manufacturer instructions. 2.0101.2c.



Provide occupants with the manufacturer written instructions. 2.0101.2d.
