#### Significant Accomplishments: (No more than 5)

Achieved over 3.1 million work hours without a lost time accident, a new record for the life of the contract.

Provided outstanding support to DOE by accomplishing work above-and-beyond the planned FY 2024 scope to advance the Paducah Site mission.

Provided outstanding support to DOE with the development of a holistic approach to environmental remediation at the Paducah Site.

Awarded approximately 67% of procurements to small businesses, exceeding goals established in the Small Business Subcontracting Plan.

#### Opportunities for Improvement: (No more than 2)

Although FY 2024 saw a notable decrease in Incidents of Security Concern (IOSCs), FRNP should continue to focus on reducing IOSCs and fostering a strong security culture.

Management continued initiatives to integrate with the Portsmouth Team and leverage lessons learned from similar projects and activities. FRNP should similarly leverage experience by adopting Nuclear Criticality Safety Evaluations successfully implemented at Portsmouth for deactivation activities.
