Pursuant to Condition J of DOE/FE Order No. 3968 (as amended by DOE/FE Order No. 3968-A and DOE/FE Order No. 3968-B), and Condition M of DOE/FE Order No. 4373 (as amended by DOE/FE Order No. 4373-A and DOE/FE Order No. 4373-B), Louisiana LNG Infrastructure LLC ("LALNG") is providing herein the semi-annual status report for the Woodside Louisiana LNG Facility (the "Project") for the period October 1, 2024 through March 31, 2025.

LALNG has obtained all applicable federal and state permits required for the Project at this time.

During this reporting period, construction continued for the Project. Construction activities included the following for general site preparation: excavation and backfill, storm water management, dry excavation, vegetation burning activities, and earth work activities for the south berm. Work at the "material off-loading dock" included the installation of tie-back wall. Within the process areas, work continued with mud mat installation, pile driving, rebar/formwork in Plant 1 and tanks, foundation pours in Plant 1, and wick drain installation.

Non-jurisdictional construction activities, including the construction of water wells, also continued during the reporting period.

LALNG is continuing to develop and negotiate terms for long-term LNG export contracts and long-term supply contracts for the Project. In accordance with Conditions D(1) and D(2) of DOE/FE Order No. 3968, and Conditions I(i) and I(ii) of DOE/FE Order No. 4373, LALNG will file copies of long-term contracts following execution.
