Long-Term Natural Gas Supply Agreement**

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To Whom It May Concern:

Pursuant to the Authorizations<sup>1</sup> issued by the U.S. Department of Energy, Office of Fossil Energy and Carbon Management (“DOE/FECM”) to Rio Grande LNG, LLC (“Rio Grande”), NextDecade LNG, LLC (“NextDecade”) hereby submits a summary of major contract provisions<sup>2</sup> as well as a non-redacted copy of the Base Contract for Sale and Purchase of Natural Gas between Rio Grande LNG Gas Marketing LLC, an affiliate of Rio Grande, and Vitol Inc. (together, the “Parties”) and an associated Transaction Confirmation dated May 8, 2025 (“Agreement”).

Condition D(ii) of Order No. 3869 and Condition I(ii) of Order No. 4492 require Rio Grande to file, or cause others to file, with the Office of Regulation, Analysis, and Engagement a non-redacted copy of all executed long-term contracts associated with the long-term supply of natural gas. Additionally, DOE/FECM has stated that such long-term contracts may be filed under seal because it “recognizes that some information in ... long-term contracts associated with the long-term supply of natural gas to the Rio Grande Terminal, may be commercially sensitive.”<sup>3</sup> DOE/FECM has provided that, should Rio Grande file, or cause to be filed, long-term contracts

under seal, it also must file either: (i) a copy of the long-term contract with commercially sensitive information redacted, or (ii) a summary of all major provisions of the contract.

The Agreement contains significant, sensitive privileged and confidential information that is both commercial and financial, the release of which would cause competitive and financial harm to the Parties by providing such proprietary, commercially valuable information to competitors and future counterparties. Therefore, the Agreement is being provided to DOE/FECM under seal, via overnight mail. In this regard, and consistent with Order Nos. 3869 and 4492, Attachment A hereto provides a public summary of the major provisions of the Agreement.

The Annual Contract Quantity of natural gas is approximately 54,750,000 MMBtu for the first nine years, then approximately 36,500,000 MMBtu for the remaining 1.25 years.

**8. Take or Pay Provisions:**

Pursuant to the terms of the contract, in respect of any day, the Seller is obliged to deliver to Buyer a specified quantity of gas, or compensate the Buyer if not made available, unless otherwise excused under the contract. Similarly, in respect of any day, the Buyer is obliged to take a specified quantity of gas, or compensate the Seller if not taken, unless otherwise excused under the contract.
