**NOTICE OF CLARIFICATION OF  
THE ORGANIZATION OF MISO STATES, INC.**

On June 23, 2025, pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 825~~l~~ and the procedures set forth by the U.S. Department of Energy (“DOE”),<sup>1</sup> the Organization of MISO States, Inc. (“OMS”) timely submitted a Petition to Intervene and Request for Rehearing<sup>2</sup> in the above-referenced proceeding. This proceeding regards the continued operation of Consumers Energy Company’s J.H. Campbell Generating Facility pursuant to DOE’s May 23, 2025 Order under Section 202(c) of the Federal Power Act.<sup>3</sup> OMS now submits this Notice of Clarification to reflect the members of OMS that voted in support of a Petition to Intervene in this proceeding but abstained from the vote on the Request for Rehearing.
