Contract Transition Introduction

- Contract transition is taking place this summer at the Paducah Site.
- On June 1, the site began transitioning to the new Operations and Site Mission Support (OSMS) contract.
- On August 1, Infrastructure Support Services (ISS) will begin transitioning to a new contract.





OSMS Contract

- The new OSMS contract was awarded to Mission Conversion Services Alliance (MCSA) of Oak Ridge, Tennessee in December 2024.
- Contract value is \$2.3B over a 10-year period of performance.
- Promotes community commitment and engagement
 - Community commitment plan required
 - Relies on regional vendors and purchase preference for subcontracting to regional small businesses

OSMS Contract Strategy

- Allows Deactivation & Remediation contractor, Four Rivers Nuclear Partnership, to focus on end state completion.
- Scope includes:
 - Operate Depleted Uranium Hexafluoride facilities
 - Conduct cylinder surveillance and maintenance services
 - Support disposition of uranium oxide
 - Provide Pro Force services
 - Perform emergency management and fire protection services
 - Perform surveillance and maintenance of assigned facilities
 - Operate and maintain utility services

ISS Contract

- DOE awarded the Paducah Infrastructure Support Services (ISS) contract to North Wind Dynamics, a small business in Idaho Falls, Idaho, in April 2025.
- Teaming Partners include:
 - *Swift & Staley Inc.
- Contract value is \$152.6M over five years, consisting of a three-year base period and one two-year option period.





ISS Contract Scope

- Surveillance, maintenance, and repair and construction/replacement of facilities
- Grounds maintenance, snow removal, and pest control
- Records management and document control
- Roadway parking and lot maintenance
- Real property management
- Safeguards & Security
- Fleet management
- Mail services
- Janitorial
