General Comment

Formal Objection to the Saguaro Project Extension

To Whom It May Concern:

Through this letter, I submit my formal objection to the request for an extension for the Saguaro Project, given the unacceptable environmental, social, and strategic impacts this project represents for Mexico.

My primary concern lies in the direct threat that increased LNG maritime traffic poses to the Gulf of California, our invaluable "Aquarium of the World" and a UNESCO World Heritage site. The operation of this project would significantly increase the risk of collisions with whales and other marine species, as well as underwater acoustic pollution and the possibility of spills, which would devastate an already fragile ecosystem essential for global biodiversity.

Furthermore, I am deeply concerned about the impact on local communities that depend on the health of this ecosystem for their livelihoods.
