General Comment

We respectfully urge the U.S. government to reconsider and ultimately deny the extension requested by Mexico Pacific Limited LLC for the commencement of export operations under its long-term LNG re-export authorization. The Saguaro project raises serious concerns due to:

Lack of transparency in the planning and public engagement process, both in the U.S. and Mexico;

Habitat fragmentation, particularly in sensitive desert and coastal ecosystems;

Negative impacts on coastal communities, including potential displacement and disruption of local livelihoods;

Increased methane emissions, contributing to global climate change;

Escalation in maritime traffic, with associated environmental and safety risks;

Direct threats to ecosystems and megafauna, including species that are already vulnerable or endangered.
