## General Comment

From Mexico, we firmly reject the request by Mexico Pacific Limited LLC (MXP) to the U.S. Department of Energy to extend its permit to re-export liquefied natural gas (LNG) from the Saguaro Energía Facility, located on our soil.

This project is a clear example of energy colonialism, where the U.S. seeks to use our territory as a platform to export fossil fuels to third countries—offloading the environmental, social, and territorial costs onto Mexican communities that have not been consulted or respected.

The facility is planned in Sonora, an environmentally sensitive region, near the Gulf of California—home to unique ecosystems and Indigenous and fishing communities already threatened by extractivist megaprojects.

We denounce:

The use of Mexico as a dirty backdoor for the U.S. fossil fuel industry, amid a global climate crisis.

The abusive and irresponsible practices that disregard territorial, environmental, and community rights.

The hypocrisy of promoting a “just energy transition” while expanding fossil fuel infrastructure in the Global South.

From our communities, we demand respect for sovereignty, land, and life. We will not be a sacrifice zone for U.S. corporate energy interests. Stop the re-export of gas from Mexico!
