General Comment

I strongly oppose Mexico Pacific Limited LLC's request to extend the deadline for the commencement of LNG export operations at the proposed Saguaro Energía.

Nature does not respect borders, and coastal ecosystems on Mexico's shores are directly connected to the Californian coastline via migratory wildlife paths such as gray whales, leatherback turtles, and seabird species. Any industrial activity that harms Mexican marine habitats is also damaging U.S. coastal ecosystems.

The proposed liquefaction terminal and LNG infrastructure represent a serious threat to biodiversity, climate stability, and coastal communities. These operations will disrupt habitat, increase pollution risk, and exacerbate the climate emergency.

Additionally, approving an extension without a full reassessment of the environmental and ecological implications would be inconsistent with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). DOE must evaluate how delay in operation allows more time for environmental degradation and irreversible habitat loss.

I therefore request that the Department of Energy deny the extension application, require a robust supplemental environmental impact analysis, and consider the transboundary nature of coastal ecosystems and wildlife migrations.
