General Comment

I strongly urge the US government to reject this extension to cease the viability of this project.

This project poses a great threat to Mexico's environment and biodiversity in several major ways:

- The shipping route crosses the narrow Sea of Cortez which is a hotspot for large aquatic mammals such as many species of whale which migrate periodically through this area thus increasing the likelihood of collisions and disruption of natural behavior due to noise pollution and improper discharges of waste.
- The gas pipeline from Texas to Sonora through Mexican soil will disrupt nearby communities and will be a source of methane emissions through leaks, which are hard to detect.
