ADMINISTRATIVE RECORD FILE FOR THE
C-AREA PROJECT AT THE BETTIS ATOMIC POWER
LABORATORY, WEST MIFFLIN, PENNSYLVANIA

The U.S. Department of Energy, Office of Environmental Management announces the availability of the Community Involvement Plan (CIP) and the Administrative Record file for the evaluation of removal action alternatives for buildings in the C-Area, located at the Bettis Atomic Power Laboratory in West Mifflin, Pennsylvania.

The CIP describes the public participation process regarding the outcome for the C-Area buildings. The Administrative Record file includes documents which form the basis for the selection of a removal action at the Bettis Laboratory. Documents will be added to the file as they become available, and include the Historical Site Assessment which documents the history and use of the C-Area buildings, the Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis which documents alternatives for the C-Area buildings, and the Action Memorandum, which documents the final removal action decision.
