Mr. Keith Grindstaff, 5 NNMCAB (Deputy Designated Federal Officer) DDFO, called the meeting to order at 8:32 6 a.m. 7 II. **Welcome and Introductions** 8 9 Mr. Jose Villegas welcomed everyone to the meeting and gave an introduction. Mr. Villegas 10 then asked the members to introduce themselves. 11 12 III. **Approval of Agenda** 13 The board reviewed the agenda for the November 6, 2024, meeting. Mr. Villegas asked for a 14 motion to approve the agenda as presented. 15 Mr. Patricio Pacheco made a motion to approve the agenda; Mr. Manny L'Esperance 16 seconded the motion. The agenda was approved, as presented. 17 IV. 18 **Approval of Minutes** 19 The board reviewed the minutes for the October 02, 2024, meeting. Mr. Villegas Asked for a 20 motion to approve the minutes. 21 Mr. Pacheco made a motion to approve the minutes; Ms. Elanor Bravo seconded the 22 motion. VIII. **Discussion Items**

Ms. Danielle Duran stated that Mr. Villegas and she met and discussed the gaps in information and engagement with the public. Many gaps exist, but the following are the most prevalent.

- The public is unclear about the Department of Energy's (DOE) structure at the Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL). She recommended that a DOE structural graphic be created and placed on the NNMCAB website. This will assist the public in deciphering what organization is directly related to each mission, the relationship between Triad, EM, and contractors, and assist in directing their questions to the correct entity.
- Create a DOE 101 that will offer the same information as the graphic but will also provide the history of the Pajarito Plateau and the organizational and communication structure at LANL.
- Create educational sessions that includes DOE 101 for Public Information Officers (PIO) to disseminate the information to their community members.
- Collaborate with EM/N3B to create workforce information sessions that include DOE 101. The sessions will inform the public what organizations employ them and the type of work they perform.

Questions

Mr. Grindstaff asked if the DOE 101 would remain focused on the EM-LA cleanup. Ms. Duran stated that the session would remain focused on the cleanup. The graphic will assist the public in directing their questions to the correct organization. Ms. Maestas stated the July Board Meeting presentation contained a graphic that explained the differences between DOE, National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA), LANL, and EM. The July board meeting recording can be found on YouTube and the presentation will be sent out to members. A hard copy can also be found in the July Board Meeting packet.

Ms. Duran stated that the graphic can be utilized as one of the subcommittee's tools.

Mr. Pacheco stated that he appreciates the efforts of Mr. Villegas and Ms. Duran. The information they presented is well put together and will assist in educating the public on the DOE structure and keeping transparency.

Ms. Bravo recommended that the subcommittee expand their recruitment to diverse members of the public and education of new members should be provided by existing members after their appointment to the Board.

Ms. Duran stated that much of the public does not have the time to attend meetings. However, they will attend meetings that relate to employment. Ms. Fernandez asked if the NNMCAB would be representing itself or offering employment for N3B at the workforce sessions.

1 2	Ms. Duran stated that the sessions would not discuss employment opportunities but would discuss engagement with the laboratory.
3 4 5 6	Ms. Fernandez stated that the NNMCAB would need to make its role clear at the workforce sessions. The NNMCAB must not go outside its purview. Work Plans are now done by EM, and this has made the NNMCAB less effective in creating their own Work Plans.
7 8 9	Ms. Duran stated that the NNMCAB can dictate how the session is structured and the information that will be provided. The sessions will assist in finding more gaps and engagement opportunities.
10 11	Mr. Villegas stated that each of the communities that can host sessions are along I-25.
12 13 14 15	Ms. Fernandez stated that the former NNMCAB Chair, Mr. Bob Hall and herself have presented information on the NNMCAB to the State Legislature and the Radioactive Hazardous Materials Interim Committee. NNMCAB staff have the materials that were presented, and they may assist with providing that information.
16 17	Ms. Maestas stated that she would share the materials presented by Mr. Hall and suggested that a newsletter be created by the Public Outreach Subcommittee.
18	Mr. Grindstaff asked if Public Outreach is found in past Work Plans.
19 20	Ms. Maestas stated that 2023 was the first year a Work Plan was created for the entire group and not for the individual committees.
21 22 23	Ms. Santistevan stated that public outreach and public education are under the scope of the NNMCAB. Work plans are now created by EM-LA with approval by headquarters.
24 25	Mr. Villegas requested a copy of the past Work Plans be provided to members of the board.
26 27	Ms. Maestas stated that the Fiscal Year (FY) 25 Work Plan is currently being constructed. NNMCAB staff will provide the FY24 Work Plan.
28	Mr. Pacheco asked when the FY begins.
29 30	Ms. Maestas stated that it begins on October 1 st . Mr. Grindstaff is currently working with EM-LA staff to produce the Work Plans.
31	Mr. Kovac asked for a status of the NNMCAB website.
32 33	Ms. Maestas stated that the original website is still active and being updated regularly. The new website is on hold.
34	Ms. Duran asked who created the NNMCAB logo.
35	Ms. Maestas stated that Mr. Paul Torrez created the NNMCAB and EM-LA logos.
36 37	Mr. Pacheco stated that a PowerPoint presentation should be created to present at events.
