Pursuant to the Authorizations¹ issued by the U.S. Department of Energy, Office of Fossil Energy and Carbon Management ("DOE/FECM")² to Rio Grande LNG, LLC ("RGLNG"), Rio Grande LNG Train 4, LLC ("RGLNG 4") and Rio Grande LNG Train 5, LLC ("RGLNG 5"),³ NextDecade LNG, LLC, an affiliate of the RGLNG Entities, hereby submits a summary of major contract provisions⁴ as well as a non-redacted copy of the liquefied natural gas ("LNG") sale and purchase agreement between RGLNG 5 and ConocoPhillips Marketing & Trading International LLC (together, the "Parties") dated August 29, 2025 ("Agreement").

Condition D(i) of Order No. 3869 and Condition I(i) of Order No. 4492 require the RGLNG Entities to file, or cause others to file, with the Office of Regulation, Analysis, and Engagement a

Rio Grande LNG, LLC, Order Granting Long-Term, Multi-Contract Authorization to Export Liquefied Natural Gas By Vessel From the Proposed Rio Grande LNG Terminal in Brownsville, Texas, to Free Trade Agreement Nations, DOE/FE Order No. 3869, FE Docket No. 15-190-LNG (Aug. 17, 2016) (hereinafter "Order No. 3869"), Rio Grande LNG, LLC, Opinion and Order Granting Long-Term Authorization to Export Liquefied Natural Gas to Non-Free Trade Agreement Nations, DOE/FE Order No. 4492, FE Docket No. 15-190-LNG (Feb. 10, 2020) (hereinafter "Order No. 4492"), Rio Grande LNG, LLC, Order Extending Export Term for Authorization to Non-Free Trade Agreement Nations Through December 31, 2050, DOE/FE Order No. 4492-A, FE Docket No. 15-190-LNG (Oct. 21, 2020), each as amended, Rio Grande LNG, LLC, Rio Grande LNG Train 4, LLC & Rio Grande LNG Train 5, LLC, Order Granting Request to Amend Authorizations to Export Liquefied Natural Gas to Add Authorization Holders, DOE/FECM Order Nos. 3869-A & 4492-B, FE Docket No. 15-190-LNG (Aug. 20, 2025) (collectively, "Authorizations").

DOE/FECM was previously known as the Department of Energy, Office of Fossil Energy or "DOE/FE". In this regard, DOE/FE and DOE/FECM are used interchangeably herein.

non-redacted copy of all executed long-term contracts associated with the long-term export of LNG. Additionally, DOE/FECM has stated that such long-term contracts may be filed under seal because it "recognizes that some information in … long-term commercial agreements associated with the export of LNG … may be commercially sensitive." DOE/FECM has provided that, should the RGLNG Entities file, or cause to be filed, long-term contracts under seal, they also must file either: (i) a copy of the long-term contract with commercially sensitive information redacted, or (ii) a summary of all major provisions of the contract.

The Agreement contains significant, sensitive privileged and confidential information that is both commercial and financial, the release of which would cause competitive and financial harm to the Parties by providing such proprietary, commercially valuable information to competitors and future counterparties. Therefore, the Agreement is being provided to DOE/FECM under seal, via overnight mail. In this regard, and consistent with Order Nos. 3869 and 4492, Attachment A hereto provides a public summary of the major provisions of the Agreement.

Attachment A LNG Sale and Purchase Agreement Public Summary

1. DOE Order/FE Docket No(s):

DOE/FECM Order Nos. 3869, 3869-A, 4492, 4492-A & 4492-B FE Docket No. 15-190-LNG

2. LNG Liquefaction/Export Facility and Location:

The proposed natural gas liquefaction and export facility constructed and operated by Rio Grande LNG, LLC, Rio Grande LNG Train 4, LLC and Rio Grande LNG Train 5, LLC to be located along the north embankment of the Brownsville Ship Channel in Cameron County, Texas (the "Rio Grande LNG Terminal").

3. Describe affiliation with the Export Facility (e.g. owner, capacity holder etc.):

The Seller is Rio Grande LNG Train 5, LLC, an export authorization holder under DOE/FECM Order Nos. 3869, 3869-A, 4492, 4492-A & 4492-B. Rio Grande LNG Train 5, LLC will own the fifth liquefaction train ("Train 5") at the Rio Grande LNG Terminal.

4. Exact Legal Name of Parties/Counterparties to Contract:

Seller: Rio Grande LNG Train 5, LLC

Buyer: ConocoPhillips Marketing & Trading International LLC

5a. Contract Type:

LNG Sale and Purchase Agreement (FOB Delivery Basis)

5b. Firm of Interruptible:

6. Date of the Contract:

August 29, 2025

7. Contract Term:

The agreement is effective from the effective date of August 29, 2025, and is in force for a period of 20 years from the date of first commercial delivery from Train 5, unless adjusted in accordance with the provisions of the agreement, with an option to extend the term for an additional five years (which may be further extended in accordance with the provisions of the agreement), unless terminated earlier in accordance with the provisions of the agreement.

8. Quantity (Annual and Total, if appropriate, include +/-% flexibility):

The Annual Contract Quantity of LNG is 52,000,000 MMBtu, unless adjusted in accordance with the provisions of the agreement.

9. Take or Pay Provisions (or equivalent) Provisions/Conditions (please describe):

The agreement includes provisions that require the Buyer to pay the Seller for the Buyer's unexcused failure to take delivery of a cargo, in accordance with the provisions of the agreement.

10. Supplier (title holder) of Natural Gas to Liquefaction Facility (include whether long or short-term supply, or both), if appropriate. If this does not include the Purchase or Sale of Natural Gas, please mark this Section "Not Applicable":

The LNG sales and purchase agreement restricts delivery of LNG received by Buyer from Seller to destination countries permitted under the applicable DOE/FECM authorization.

The LNG sale and purchase agreement contains provisions providing that the Buyer may only resell or transfer LNG to countries and/or purchasers that have agreed in writing to limit their direct or indirect resale or transfer of such LNG to destination countries permitted and lawful under the applicable DOE/FECM authorization, and that each party agrees to comply with the DOE/FECM authorizations, including incorporating into any resale agreement for LNG (sold under the LNG sale and purchase agreement) the necessary conditions to ensure compliance with the DOE/FECM authorizations.
