ORDER GRANTING REQUEST TO AMEND AUTHORIZATION TO EXPORT NATURAL GAS TO MEXICO TO REFLECT CORPORATE NAME CHANGE

DOE/FECM ORDER NO. 5259-A

On February 28, 2025, the Office of Fossil Energy and Carbon Management (FECM) of the Department of Energy (DOE) issued DOE/FECM Order No. 5259 (Docket No. 25-10-NG), under section 3 of the Natural Gas Act (NGA).¹ That order granted the entity known at the time as West Texas Gas Utility, LLC (West Texas Gas Utility) authorization to export up to 50 billion cubic feet of natural gas to Mexico by pipeline, for a two-year term that began on March 12, 2025, and extends through March 11, 2027.

On October 10, 2025, DOE was notified that West Texas Gas Utility's corporate name had been changed to "Texas Pipeline Exports, LLC" (Texas Pipeline Exports), effective October 7, 2025. Texas Pipeline Exports states that this is a corporate name change due to a change in company ownership.²

DOE finds that Texas Pipeline Export's request to amend the specified authorization to reflect its corporate name change is consistent with the public interest, pursuant to NGA section 3.

ORDER

Pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, it is ordered that:

A. The name of the authorization holder of DOE/FECM Order No. 5259 is amended to Texas Pipeline Exports, LLC.

B. All obligations arising under DOE/FECM Order No. 5259 no longer apply to West Texas Gas Utility, LLC, and now apply to Texas Pipeline Exports, LLC.
