Proposed Action Title: Modification of Pantex Special Use Airspace, P-47

Proposed Action Description:
The proposed action would modify the existing Special Use Airspace (P-47) that is currently in effect above the U.S. Department of Energy National Nuclear Security Administration (DOE/NNSA) Pantex Plant property and neighboring Texas Tech University System (TTSU) property. In response to property boundary agreements executed between the TTUS and the DOE/NNSA, adjustments to the P-47 Prohibite Airspace boundary and Uncrewed Aerial System (UAS) Restricted Airspace boundary is required. This request would improve national security by allowing the federal control of the airspace vital for the DOE/NNSA in protecting the nation's nuclear weapon stockpile.
