Dear FECM Communications Team,

I am reaching out with deep concern regarding the potential extension of Mexico Pacific's export permit. This decision could have dire consequences for the Gulf of California, a vital marine habitat home to rare and endangered species.

The vaquita porpoise population has dwindled to critical levels, with fewer than a dozen remaining. Alongside them, blue whales and sea turtles depend on these waters for survival. Introducing industrial LNG infrastructure will only amplify the threats they face, putting these precious ecosystems in jeopardy.

The Department of Energy holds the authority to safeguard public interest, especially as sustainable energy solutions become more accessible and economically prudent. Supporting this permit extension will disproportionately benefit private entities while the environmental costs will be borne by the public for generations to come.

I implore you, for the sake of our environment and future generations, to reject Mexico Pacific's permit extension.
