Based on my review of the information concerning the proposed action, as NEPA Compliance Officer (authorized under DOE Policy 451.1), I have made the following determination:

Description:

**B1.15 Support** buildings

Siting, construction or modification, and operation of support buildings and support structures (including, but not limited to, trailers and prefabricated and modular buildings) within or contiguous to an already developed area (where active utilities and currently used roads are readily accessible). Covered support buildings and structures include, but are not limited to, those for office purposes; parking; cafeteria services; education and training; visitor reception; computer and data processing services; health services or recreation activities; routine maintenance activities; storage of supplies and equipment for administrative services and routine maintenance activities; security (such as security posts); fire protection; small-scale fabrication (such as machine shop activities), assembly, and testing of non-nuclear equipment or components; and similar support purposes, but exclude facilities for nuclear weapons activities and waste storage activities, such as activities covered in B1.10, B1.29, B1.35, B2.6, B6.2, B6.4, B6.5, B6.6, and B6.10 of this appendix.

B5.16 Solar photovoltaic systems

- (a) The installation, modification, operation, or decommissioning of commercially available solar photovoltaic systems:
  - Located on a building or other structure (such as rooftop, parking lot or facility, or mounted to signage, lighting, gates, or fences); or
  - 2.. Located within a previously disturbed or developed area.
- (b) Covered actions would be in accordance with applicable requirements (such as land use and zoning requirements) in the proposed project area and the integral elements listed at the start of appendix B of this part, and would be consistent with applicable plans for the management of wildlife and habitat, including plans to maintain habitat connectivity, and incorporate appropriate control technologies and best management practices.

#### Rationale for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is proposing to provide federal funding to the Wichita and Affiliated Tribes for the design, development, and installation of solar photovoltaic (PV) arrays.

Project activities would take place at the Sugar Creek Casino and the Sugar Creek Inn and Suites, both located in Hinton, Oklahoma. Carports would be constructed in the existing parking areas at both locations. Approximately 42 carport footings in total would be installed at a minimum depth of ten feet with an approximate diameter of two feet. PV arrays would be installed on top of the carports in both locations, and trenching would be required for electrical wiring and conduit to connect to the respective buildings. The PV array at the Casino would total approximately 1 megawatt in production capacity, while the array at the hotel would total approximately 200 kilowatts.

All ground disturbance would occur in previously disturbed areas. No new access roads would be required. Potential hazards include typical hazards associated with construction, mechanical, and electrical work, as well as working from heights. Award recipients would adhere to established health and safety policies and procedures when performing project work, and would observe all applicable federal, state, and local health, safety, and environmental regulations.

DOE has considered the scale, duration, and nature of proposed activities to determine potential impacts on resources, including those of an ecological, historical, cultural, and socioeconomic nature. DOE does not

anticipate impacts on these resources which would be considered significant or require DOE to consult with other agencies or stakeholders.

- The proposal fits within a class of actions that is listed in Appendix B to 10 CFR Part 1021 or Appendix B and C of DOE's NEPA Implementing Procedures (June 30, 2025). - There are no extraordinary circumstances related to the proposed action that may affect the significance of the environmental effects of the proposal.
- The proposed action has not been segmented to meet the definition of a categorical exclusion.
- The proposed action is categorically excluded from further NEPA review.

### NEPA PROVISION

DOE has made a final NEPA determination.

Should archaeological materials be observed during project activities, all work in the immediate vicinity must stop, and the area must be secured. The appropriate State and/or Tribal Historic Preservation Office and the DOE Project Officer shall be contacted immediately in order to help assess the situation and determine how to preserve the resource(s). Compliance with all applicable laws pertaining to archaeological resources is required.
