Subpart 936.71—Inspection and Acceptance

936.7100 Scope of subpart.

This subpart implements and supplements FAR part 36 (as implemented by DOE/NNSA class deviation) by prescribing the policies and requirements for inspection and acceptance under construction contracts.

936.7101 Construction contracts.

(a) Inspection services may be performed by the architect-engineer responsible for the design. Inspection services may not be procured from a construction contractor with respect to its own work.

(b) When one contractor is to inspect the work of another, provide the inspection contractor written instructions defining its responsibilities and stating that it is not authorized to modify the terms and conditions of the contract, direct additional work, waive any requirements of the contract, or settle any claim or dispute. Provide the instructions to the contractor who is to be inspected, with a request to acknowledge receipt. This will put both contractors on express notice regarding the authority and limitations of the inspecting contractor.
