Submission of Amended and Restated Long-Term Natural Gas Supply Agreement***

Dear Ms. Wade:

In accordance with Order No. 3968, Ordering Paragraph D(2)¹ and Order No. 4373, Ordering Paragraph I(ii)², I hereby submit to the U.S. Department of Energy, Hydrocarbons and Geothermal Energy Office (“DOE/HGEO”), on behalf of Louisiana LNG Infrastructure LLC (“Louisiana LNG”) and Louisiana LNG Gas Management, LLC (“Louisiana Gas Management”), an affiliate of Louisiana LNG, under seal, a non-redacted copy of an executed natural gas supply agreement associated with the liquefaction and export of LNG from the Woodside Louisiana LNG Project. Louisiana LNG is filing herewith the following:

- (1) Base Contract for Sale and Purchase of Natural Gas between Louisiana LNG Gas Management, LLC and BP Energy Company (together, the “Parties”) dated April 28, 2025 (the “Base Contract”);

- (2) Amended and Restated Transaction Confirmation associated with the Base Contract, dated January 12, 2026 (the “Transaction Confirmation” and together with the Base Contract, the “Contract”), which amends and restates in its entirety the Transaction Confirmation dated April 29, 2025, previously filed with DOE/HGEO on May 19, 2025; and
- (3) A summary of the major provisions of the Contract (attached as Exhibit 1 hereto).

Order Nos. 3968 and 4373 require Louisiana LNG to file, or cause others to file, with the DOE/HGEO a non-redacted copy of all executed long-term contracts associated with the long-term supply of natural gas supporting Louisiana LNG’s export operations. The Contract submitted herewith provides that BP Energy Company will sell to Louisiana Gas Management, on a long-term basis, natural gas for liquefaction and export from the Louisiana LNG Project.

The non-redacted Contract contains highly sensitive and confidential commercial, financial, and proprietary information. Accordingly, the Contract is being filed with DOE/HGEO under seal on a confidential basis and not for public disclosure, as authorized by Order No. 3968 and 4373. Louisiana LNG submits that the Contract meets the six criteria set forth in 10 C.F.R. § 1004.11(f) for determining whether information is exempt from mandatory disclosure pursuant to the Administrative Procedure Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(4):

- (1) The Contract has been held in confidence by Louisiana LNG and its counterparty, and the Contract contains a confidentiality provision.
- (2) The Contract contains information of a type that is customarily held in confidence by the Parties, and there is a reasonable basis to keep sensitive commercial terms, including but not limited to pricing terms, confidential to avoid competitive harm.
- (3) Louisiana LNG is submitting the Contract to DOE/HGEO under seal, with a request to keep the Contract confidential.
- (4) The Contract is not publicly available.
- (5) Public disclosure of the Contract by DOE/HGEO is likely to cause other export license holders or registrants to be reluctant to submit unredacted copies of their gas supply agreements to DOE/HGEO; thus, public disclosure could impair DOE/HGEO’s ability to obtain similar information from others in the future; and
- (6) Disclosure of the unredacted Contract is likely to cause substantial harm to the competitive positions of the Parties to the Contract.


For the foregoing reasons, Louisiana LNG respectfully requests that the non-redacted copies of the Contract be kept confidential by DOE/HGEO.

SUMMARY OF MAJOR PROVISIONS

Natural Gas Sale and Purchase Agreement dated January 12, 2026

1. DOE Order/FE Docket No(s):

DOE/FE Order Nos. 3968, 3968-A, 3968-B, 4373, 4373-A and 4373-B

FE Docket No. 16-144-LNG

2. LNG Liquefaction/Export Facility and Location:

The proposed natural gas liquefaction and export facility constructed and operated by Louisiana LNG Infrastructure LLC to be located near the city of Carlyss in Calcasieu Parish, Louisiana.

3. Describe affiliation with the Export Facility (e.g., owner, capacity holder, etc.):

The Buyer is Louisiana LNG Gas Management, LLC, an affiliate of the export authorization holder, Louisiana LNG Infrastructure LLC, under DOE/FE Order Nos. 3968, 3968-A, 3968-B, 4373, 4373-A & 4373-B.

4. Exact Legal Name of Parties/Counterparties to Contract:

Seller: BP Energy Company (“Seller”)

Buyer: Louisiana LNG Gas Management, LLC (“Buyer”)

5. Contract Type:

NAESB Base Contract for Sale and Purchase of Natural Gas and Amended and Restated Transaction Confirmation

6. Date of the Contract:

April 28, 2025 (Base Contract for Sale and Purchase of Natural Gas) and January 12, 2026 (Amended and Restated Transaction Confirmation)

7. Supply Period:

Seven years.

8. Quantity:

The quantity of natural gas is 250,000 MMBtu per day, which may be increased in accordance with certain other provisions of the agreement.

9. Take or Pay (or equivalent) Provisions/Conditions:

Pursuant to the terms of the contract, in respect of any day, the Seller is obliged to deliver to Buyer a specified quantity of gas, or compensate the Buyer if not made available, unless otherwise excused under the contract. Similarly, in respect of any day, the Buyer is obliged to take a specified quantity of gas, or compensate the Seller if not taken, unless otherwise excused under the contract.
