ORDER GRANTING REQUEST TO VACATE LONG-TERM AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS

DOE/HGEO ORDER NO. 1115-C

APRIL 30, 2026

On November 7, 1995, in DOE/FE Order No. 1115, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) (now known as the Hydrocarbons and Geothermal Energy Office)¹ of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Distrigas Corporation to import liquefied natural gas (LNG) “from Trinidad and other countries” in a volume up to the equivalent of 100 billion cubic feet (Bcf) per year (Bcf/yr) of natural gas.² On December 17, 2010, following the merger of the authorization holder, DOE amended Order No. 1115 “to substitute GDF SUEZ Gas NA LLC as the importer of LNG.”³ On January 17, 2017, DOE amended Order No. 1115 again, this time to reflect the corporate name change of GDF SUEZ Gas NA LLC to “ENGIE Gas & LNG LLC” (ENGIE LNG NA).⁴ Order No. 1115, as amended, authorizes ENGIE LNG NA to import LNG for a 40-year term that began on May 6, 1999, and extends through May 5, 2039.⁵

On April 10, 2026, ENGIE LNG NA notified DOE that this authorization is no longer needed.⁶ ENGIE LNG NA requests that DOE vacate Order No. 1115, as amended, effective October 1, 2019.⁷ DOE finds good cause to do so.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, ENGIE LNG NA’s long-term authorization to import LNG up to the equivalent of 100 Bcf/yr of natural gas from Trinidad and
