## **945.000 Scope of part.**

This part implements and supplements FAR Part 45 for Department of Energy (DOE) and National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA) acquisitions. All FAR references in this part are to be read as implemented through the DOE and NNSA class deviations that implemented the Revolutionary FAR Overhaul at DOE and NNSA. This, and FAR part 45 are not applicable to the management of property by management and operating (M&O) contractors or other on-site contractors designated in 41 CFR chapter 109, unless otherwise stated in the applicable contract.

## **Subpart 945.1—General**

### **945.102-72 Reporting of contractor sensitive property inventory.**

### **945.170 Providing special nuclear material to contractors.**

#### **945.170-1 Policy.**

(a) This policy applies to DOE contracts involving the fabrication, conversion, or scrap recovery of special nuclear material. *Special nuclear material* means uranium enriched in the isotopes U233 or U235, and/or plutonium, other than PU238. The policies to be followed are:

(b) DOE will furnish special nuclear material for fixed-price contracts and subcontracts, at any tier, that require the production of special nuclear products, including fabrication and conversion, for Government use. To receive special nuclear material, contractors and subcontractors must possess the appropriate license(s) from the Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

(c) Contracts and subcontracts for fabricating end items using special nuclear material or conversion or scrap recovery of special nuclear material are to be fixed-price. Other contract types may be used only with the approval of the Head of the Contracting Activity. This approval authority is not delegable.
