Assignment of Long-Term Contract

Dear Ms. Sweeney:

Sabine Pass Liquefaction, LLC ("SPL") and Sabine Pass Liquefaction Stage V, LLC (together with SPL, "Sabine Pass") hereby submit¹ for filing under seal, a non-redacted copy of the Novation and Amendment Agreement dated June 26, 2026 among Cheniere Marketing, LLC ("Cheniere Marketing"), SPL, and Equinor ASA (the "Novation Agreement"). The Novation Agreement assigns to SPL the previously submitted long-term sale and purchase agreement entered into by Cheniere Marketing and Equinor ASA on June 8, 2022 (the "SPA"). Upon the effectiveness of the Novation Agreement, Cheniere Marketing ceased to be a party to the SPA and SPL became the "seller" under the SPA.

Sabine Pass is also filing herewith a public summary of the major provisions of the SPA, as assigned and amended by the Novation Agreement. This filing is being submitted in accordance with Department of Energy, Hydrocarbons and Geothermal Energy Office ("DOE/HGEO") Order Nos. 2833, 2961-A, 3306, 3307, 3384, 3595, 3669, 3792, 4520, 4800, and 5181 (each as may have been amended).² Sabine Pass hereby request confidential treatment of the Novation

**LNG SALE AND PURCHASE AGREEMENT (FOB), DATED JUNE 8, 2022, BETWEEN
SABINE PASS LIQUEFACTION, LLC (AS ASSIGNEE OF CHENIERE MARKETING, LLC)
AND EQUINOR ASA, AS ASSIGNED AND AMENDED BY THE NOVATION AND
AMENDMENT AGREEMENT, DATED JUNE 26, 2026**

2. LNG Liquefaction/Export Facility and Location:

LNG may be delivered by Seller to Buyer at the Sabine Pass LNG Terminal located in Cameron Parish, Louisiana or at any number of liquefaction plants, subject to the terms and conditions of the contract.

3. Describe affiliation with LNG Liquefaction Export Facility (e.g., owner, capacity holder, etc):

The contract was initially entered into by Cheniere Marketing, LLC. Cheniere Marketing, LLC has assigned the contract to Sabine Pass Liquefaction, LLC, the owner of the Sabine Pass LNG Terminal.

4. Exact Legal Name of Parties/Counterparties to Contract:

Seller: Sabine Pass Liquefaction, LLC
Buyer: Equinor ASA

5. a. Contract Type (e.g. Purchase and Sale Agreement; Liquefaction Tolling Agreement, etc.):

LNG Sale and Purchase Agreement

b. Firm or Interruptible Contract:

6. Date of the Contract:

June 8, 2022 (as amended effective June 26, 2026)

7. Contract Term:

Pursuant to the terms of the contract, a supply period of approximately fifteen (15) years, beginning in 2026.

8. Annual Quantity:

A plateau quantity of approximately 90,000,000 MMBtus per full calendar year (with a lower annual quantity during each of the first two years), subject to the terms and conditions of the contract.

9. Take or Pay (or equivalent) Provisions/Conditions:

Pursuant to the terms of the contract, during any contract year, the Seller is obliged to make available to Buyer the scheduled cargo quantity, or compensate Buyer if not made available, unless otherwise excused under the contract. Similarly, during any contract year, the Buyer is obliged to take and pay for the scheduled cargo quantity, or compensate the Seller if not taken, unless otherwise excused under the contract.

10. Supplier (title holder) of Natural Gas to Liquefaction Facility (Include whether long or short-term supply, or both), if appropriate:

12. Export Destination Restrictions in the Contract:

The contract restricts resale or transfer of LNG received by the Buyer under the contract to destination countries permitted under (i) the applicable DOE/HGEO export authorizations and (ii) U.S. law.

13. Resale Provisions:

The contract provides for the parties to agree to comply with the applicable export authorizations, including incorporating into any resale contract for LNG sold under the contract the necessary conditions to ensure compliance with the applicable export authorizations.
